

Political Position Statement of the National Unity Consultative Council (NUCC) on the Occasion of the 81st Birthday of State Counsellor Daw Aung San Suu Kyi

June 19, 2026

1. Today marks the 81st birthday of State Counsellor Daw Aung San Suu Kyi, who has for many decades stood at the forefront of the struggle for democracy and the fight against dictatorship in Myanmar, and who is currently being unjustly arrested and detained by the terrorist military junta. On this day, the National Unity Consultative Council (NUCC) pays its highest respects and solemn tribute to the State Counsellor, to all political prisoners undergoing unjust detention, to all comrades who have sacrificed their lives, blood, and sweat in the Spring Revolution, and to the entire population.
2. To fundamentally resolve the political crisis in Myanmar, the primary objectives of the Spring Revolution are the definitive termination of all forms of dictatorship, including military dictatorship, and the establishment of a Federal Democratic Union. In accordance with the principles outlined in the Federal Democracy Charter (FDC), the NUCC is fostering a new political landscape founded upon equality, self-determination, and justice.
3. The NUCC hereby reaffirms the following political positions:
 - (a) We strongly reject the terrorist military junta's illegal coup and shall continue to fight alongside all revolutionary forces until the military dictatorship is completely eradicated.
 - (b) We shall persevere in our efforts to secure the immediate and unconditional release of State Counsellor Daw Aung San Suu Kyi and all political prisoners.
 - (c) Without prioritising the leadership of any single individual or organisation, we shall intensify our efforts to build a Federal Democratic Union through "Collective Leadership", involving all ethnic nationalities and all State/Federal Units.
4. The current Spring Revolution is a collective revolution aimed at systemic change. The most profound commitment we can offer on the State Counsellor's birthday is to collectively demonstrate our success in building a Federal Democratic Union, wherein dictatorship is permanently ended, and sovereign power is returned to the people.



5. Therefore, the NUCC, guided by the Federal Democracy Charter (FDC), solemnly pledges on this day to continue its march along the federal democratic path in unified solidarity with Ethnic Revolutionary Organisations (EROs), political parties, civil society organisations, strike committees, and all other revolutionary forces.
